




Saman Zahawi

Background

Saman Zahawi is a celebrated Iraqi-Canadian artist and architect born in Baghdad in 1967. He has redefined the realm of Arabic calligraphy, creating a unique artistic interpretation that blends profound spirituality with bold philosophical narratives.

His art serves as a bridge between tradition and modernity, employing stark black and white contrasts to explore life's extremes—victory and defeat, life and death, hope and despair. Each of his pieces reveals layers of meanings that invite viewers into a contemplative journey, exploring the deeper dimensions of the human experience.



Artistic Philosophy and Style (1 of 3)

Zahawi's artistic journey is deeply rooted in his heritage and personal philosophy. He re-invents Arabic fonts, transforming them into a medium that represents visual beauty and the rich cultural and spiritual undertones of the Arabic language.

His art reflects a deep engagement with dualities and contradictions, often presenting viewers with two initial dimensions; a composition that invites immediate visual engagement and an underlying layer that offers a deeper, more complex narrative.



Artistic Philosophy and Style (2 of 3)

Zahawi uses the black and white extremities to accentuate his themes, creating a powerful visual tension that draws the eye and mind into contemplation. His unique Arabic font, developed entirely through his own artistic explorations, sets his work apart, distinguishing it from traditional calligraphy.

Each artwork is a study in contrast of light and shadow, simplicity and complexity offering viewers a meditative experience that transcends the mere visual.




Artistic Philosophy and Style (3 of 3)

The philosophy behind Saman's art is deeply rooted in the contemplative and mystical traditions of various spiritual beliefs serving as a profound source of inspiration. Those draws from the essence of a single word or quote, allowing it to unfold into a visual and narrative journey.

Each piece serves as a meditation on the inherent contrasts and dualities of existence: life and death, light and darkness, stillness and movement. The use of black and white, a signature of Saman's work, symbolizes these extremes, portraying the tension and harmony that exist within the human experience.






The Beginning

In 2018, during a business trip that was meant to be simple and straightforward, circumstances quickly became complicated, prompting an extended stay abroad. In a moment of unplanned creativity, Zahawi stumbled upon a stationery shop, where he found large sheets of paper and pens.

To occupy his time, he began sketching and, almost unintentionally, created his first artwork, "The Iceberg." The piece was a reflection of that trip: the visible tip of an iceberg represented the straightforward nature he initially expected, while the tangled mix of fonts and codes beneath symbolized the hidden complexities and unseen challenges, much like those we encounter in life. This marked the unexpected beginning of Zahawi's journey into art.














Participations and Exhibitions (2 of 4)



Integrated writings representing the details of our lives split and fade in the midst of this virus, both small and significant at the same time, symbolizing the distortion it imposed on the depth of our reality back then.

Within the interplay of black darkness, the virus lurks, but the idea transcends it, connecting to our reality on a deeper level. The black color blends the symbolic aspect of the virus with its actual impact on our lives, depicting the effective similarity between small effects and fundamental changes in our daily lives.

In this painting, art harmonizes with reality, as the image opens windows for contemplation on how small factors can weave their way into the fabric of our lives and change our paths in unimaginable ways, infused with feelings of sadness and reflection on the reality of this changing small world




The Virus

In this artwork, "Me," this word expands and swells with pride, topped by radiations indicating an unwavering belief that the self surpasses humanity. Stretching to the left of the canvas is a vast array of radiations and expressions symbolizing progress and diverse cultures. On the right side, civic shapes take on various forms, mirroring cultural diversity and global variety.

While many elevate themselves to the center of the world, this artwork harmonizes with the small reality of the individual in the face of this vast universe. The magnified word "Me" appears as a monarch at the center of life, but beneath it reveals the fragility of the illusion, where the individual immerses into their creation to find that they are a small part of this grand display.


In this poetic portrayal, I see "Me" as an unreal ghost that deceives reality, where many overlook the truth of being a small part in the grandeur of this world.



In this artwork titled "Words," words accelerate aimlessly, converging to form a scene of empty discourse. The abundance and swirling of these words depict a conversation lacking clear meaning, fading into a sea of banality. Here, ink dances soullessly, and the rays inhale an empty breath.


Words without impact scatter like melting snowflakes, creating a masterpiece that narrates the story of silence and emptiness amidst the chaos of incomprehensible chatter. The scattered phrases reflect empty personalities, intertwined in an endless dance, while the radiations of words emerge, indicating the margins of the empty dialogue expressing the lost depth.

Thus, the painting "Words" manifests as a visual testimony to the lost significance of whispers, where speech draws irregular lines, reflecting conversations that neither understand nor construct.



"Death, Life... When and How?" In this distinct artwork, different from the rest, the delicate balance between life and death is manifested in a unique style. This contrast is embodied in the simplicity of lines and minimal external interventions. The word "Death" appears stably and prominently at the top, while the word "Life" reflects simplicity and beauty below, connected by the thin line that unifies them, portraying the harmonious intersection and divergence of life and death.


At the heart of this line, a circle endlessly rotates, within which symbols of questioning and wonder illuminate the meaning of "Life and Death" with an infinite touch. This painting reflects the poetic expression of life's mysteries and alternating surprises between death and life, while the thin line continues to sketch the essence of our daily lives, capable of encountering death at any moment.



This artistic piece titled "Yearning" beautifully captures the boundless expressive depth of the word "Yearning." The delicate radiations emanating from the depiction of this word reflect an infinite power of yearning, creating an impact that reaches endlessly. The varied rendering of the word makes it the focal point, with infinite radiations, adding a sense of movement and boundless emotion to the visual experience.


It is a piece that intersects visual beauty and emotional depth, evoking palpable feelings and granting the word "Yearning" an unforgettable impact.




أنا، انت ... كنا وكان





the interweaving of scattered words against an

The word "ignorance" stands out at the heart of
the painting, where its letters vary between
graceful flow and conflicting roughness,
symbolizing the inherent contradictory nature of
ignorance itself.

The broken background of words reflects the chaos and asymmetry carried by ignorance, illustrating the disparity between thoughts and knowledge. Thorn-like characters represent the challenges of understanding and obstacles imposed by ignorance, while some characters appear beautifully, serving as a reminder of the beauty that can be achieved through learning and comprehension.

This painting silently speaks to us about the impact of ignorance in our society, where understanding is blurred, and knowledge is conflicting. Yet, at the same time, learning can unite beauty and challenges in an attempt to overcome this complex reality.








